



CASA Cards Guidelines for Artwork Consideration

Please consider donating the use of your original artwork for the annual CASA of NH card fundraising project. The proceeds raised from selling these packaged cards remains in New Hampshire to help defray the costs of the important work of the CASA program. Your artwork, if selected by the CASA Card committee, will be part of a series of greeting cards. The print quality of these 4.5"x6" cards is excellent. This is a great opportunity for you to use your talent to support a valuable organization.

Selection Guidelines:

- New Hampshire artist and/or NH themed designed
- *All ages are welcome!* Teachers/Camp counselors, please consider a class project
- Watercolors, acrylics, oil, pastels, photographs, graphic arts and drawings will be considered
- Colorful children's art, seasonal (any season), NH motifs, religious holiday (Christmas- liturgical and classic, Hanukah, Thanksgiving and New Year's), birthday, thank you, and sympathy ideas will all be considered
- Up to three (3) pieces per artist will be accepted for review
- For the review stage we only accept digital files or good quality color copies: i.e. color photos or color laser copies
- If selected, we will ask for original artwork if needed to make the best quality image

Artwork submissions are requested each year by **July 15**.
