

Ultimate Games Guide

OVERALL Game Play

There are eight hours during the day with activities that score points. Point system:

- First place: 30 points
- Second place: 20 points
- Third place: 10 points

*The stein-hoist competition will have additional placement points. Five points will be awarded to those who compete in the final but place outside of the top three.

There is a game with only one winner:

- The team that raises the most money **by 9 p.m. on March 9**. The team with the most money raised by the end of the event earns 30 bonus points. There are no second or third place points for this.

There will be two team prizes at the end of the day:

- The team that raised the most money overall
- The team that scored the most overall points

Individual Game Play

Noon: Bingo

- Points will be awarded to the first person or people to call Bingo. If multiple people call Bingo at the same time, each team will be awarded that round's points.
- For the 30-point game (the third round) the first person to CALL out Bingo (and have Bingo) will be awarded the prize and medal for that round. Any additional players with a simultaneous Bingo will receive points.

THREE ROUNDS OF STANDARD BINGO: One line up and down, across or diagonal. Winner(s) of round 1 will receive 10 points, winner(s) of round 2 will receive 20 points, and winner(s) of round 3 will receive 30 points.

1 p.m. Rebus Puzzles

PLEASE NOTE: Cell phone use is not allowed. We have had numerous complaints of people cheating during puzzle rounds at past events. Please don't make us be mean and DQ your team from the round if you get caught cheating.

- Rebus puzzles are visual riddles.
- Each team is given two puzzle sheets and an answer sheet. Please keep them face down until game play starts.

- When you hear “go,” flip and start working.
- We ask that two teammates only assist at the bar for the majority of the time. A second set of the same puzzles will be provided for teammates to work on in another location.
- Teams can take as long as they need, but when you turn in your sheet, we’ll write the time at the top. There will be no ties this round. The tie-breaker for this round is based on who turned their sheet in first.

Winners are the top three teams with the most points/completed the fastest. The barstool sitter for the top scoring team will win a medal. Like the other trivia rounds, points are 30, 20 and 10 for top finishers, NOT the number of points you scored on the puzzles.

2 p.m.: Ugly Sweater Contest

Bust out your loudest, ugliest sweater to win this contest! Christmas sweaters absolutely count, but all types of eye-sore sweaters are welcome.

- While teammates may participate, **the only sweater judged will be the one worn by the occupant of the barstool** for this hour.
- A panel of judges will determine the winner and two runners-up. First place is 30 points, second is 20, and third is 10.

3 p.m.: Stein Hoisting – Participant must have someone sub for them on stool while they compete

- Five heats of 5-6 teams. One winner from each heat
- Each competitor will be given a stein full of water.
- They must hold it with one arm straight in front of body at shoulder height.
- You are out if you drop your arm, bend at the elbow or if you shake to the point that your water is spilling.
- Winner of each heat is the last person with their glass still raised.
- Five heat winners will compete in the finals beginning at 3:50 p.m.
- Winner of the finals will earn the prize, medal and 30 points. (Points will be awarded to all who compete in the finals 30, 20, 10 and 5 each for 4th and 5th place.)

4 p.m.: Name the Beer Label

PLEASE NOTE: Cell phone use is not allowed during name that label. We have had numerous complaints of people cheating in during these rounds at past events. Please don't make us be mean and DQ your team from the round if you get caught cheating.

- Everyone will be given a sheet with 12 beer labels with the names removed, plus an answer sheet.
- When you hear “go,” flip and start working.

- We ask that two teammates only assist at the bar for the majority of the time. A second set of the same labels will be provided for teammates to work on in another location.
- Teams can take as long as they need, but when you turn in your sheet, we'll write the time at the top. There will be no ties this round. The tie-breaker for this round is based on who turned their sheet in first.
- Winners are the top three teams with the most points/completed the fastest. The barstool sitter for the top scoring team will win a medal. Like the other trivia rounds, points are 30, 20 and 10 for top finishers, NOT the number of points you scored on the labels.

5-7 p.m.: Music break! Enjoy the musical stylings of Rebel Collective

You must still have someone on your bar stool during these two hours.

7 p.m.: Memory

PLEASE NOTE: Cell phone use is not allowed during memory. We have had numerous complaints of people cheating in during these rounds at past events. Please don't make us be mean and DQ your team from the round if you get caught cheating.

- Everyone will be given one 11 x 14-inch board with dozens of items pictured on it.
- You will have a set amount of time to be announced at the beginning of the round to review it and memorize as many things on it as you can.
- When time is called, please flip the board facedown and on your scoresheet write down as many items as you can remember.
- This is a game to be played by the bar stool sitter only. Teammates should not be supplying them with answers.
- The person with the most correct answers wins the medal and 30 points for their team. Points will be awarded to second and third place as well.

8 p.m.: Coloring Contest

Nominate your most creative teammate for this hour!

- All teams will be given the same outline and coloring implements.
- If the barstool occupant would like input, teammates may add their own artistic touches.
- A panel of judges will determine the top three works of art. First place receives 30 points, second place 20 points, and third place 10 points.

9 p.m.: Spin the Wheel of (Mis)Fortune

- We have a prize wheel that will have point values allotted to each slot. They may be points added to your team total, or points subtracted from your team total. Or perhaps you spin a zero.
- We will start at one end of the bar and the bar stool sitter will have one spin to potentially improve their team's score for the day, or maybe do a little damage.

10 p.m.: Closing ceremony

Points and final donations will be tallied. Winners will be announced, team prizes will be awarded, thank-yous will be given. Please make sure you still have someone on your bar stool for this final hour!
